He will have some pre-cut stencil-like patterns available, and of course, the members will be able to 'freehand' using the tool.

BOARD MEETING NEWS...

The September 11, 2006 business meeting of the Killeen Civic Art Guild took place in the arts and crafts room at the Killeen Community Center. Juanell Skidmore took minutes for Secretary Samra Thompson, who was unable to attend. Those present were: Jutta Mack, Rob Hidalgo, Rudy Calooy, and Juanell Skidmore. The meeting began at 8:15 P.M.

Most of the business involved finalizing plans for the Conder Park Art Fair. Before President Alice Roy left for her visit in the Netherlands, she had turned over the applications and other paperwork to Jutta. Jutta reported that there were a dozen vendors who had paid. Several others had called that they had sent in their applications. Jutta and Rudy are checking on some food vendors.

Rob, who handled the children's art activities at Coloring Outside the Lines, will so it again at Conder Park.

Alice and Jutta had asked Juanell to be in charge of arranging the setup at the park and having the banners displayed, along with contacting Dr. Kott about the entertainment. Since the Fair is taking place only on Saturday, September 30 and the groups had performed only on Sundays in the past, we were not sure whether they would be able to participate. Dr. Kott said a number of the MECA groups would be able to entertain from 1:30-4:00 P.M. They will bring their own stage and other equipment,

so the parks and recreation people will not have to set up for them. Rudy agreed to check with some other musicians to see if they could perform in the morning and after 4:00 P.M.

Malcolm e-mailed Juanell that the parks department would take care of getting the park ready. Jutta, Juanell, and perhaps other members will meet with them to lay out the booths, etc. Juanell said she would contact Crown Equipment to deliver the porta-potties.

Publicity for the show was discussed. We have the announcement running weekly in "What's Happening" in the Killeen Daily Herald and the Hood Herald, and will try to get information in newspapers in the surrounding communities. We discussed having a crawler in the Weather Channel. We will request that the First National Bank and Patriot Pontiac run announcements on their marquees.

We were reminded that Young McPherson is currently exhibiting some of her works at the VLA theater. A reception will be held for her on Friday, September 15, beginning at 6:30. Members are requested to bring finger foods for refreshments.

The meeting adjourned at 9:35 P.M.
