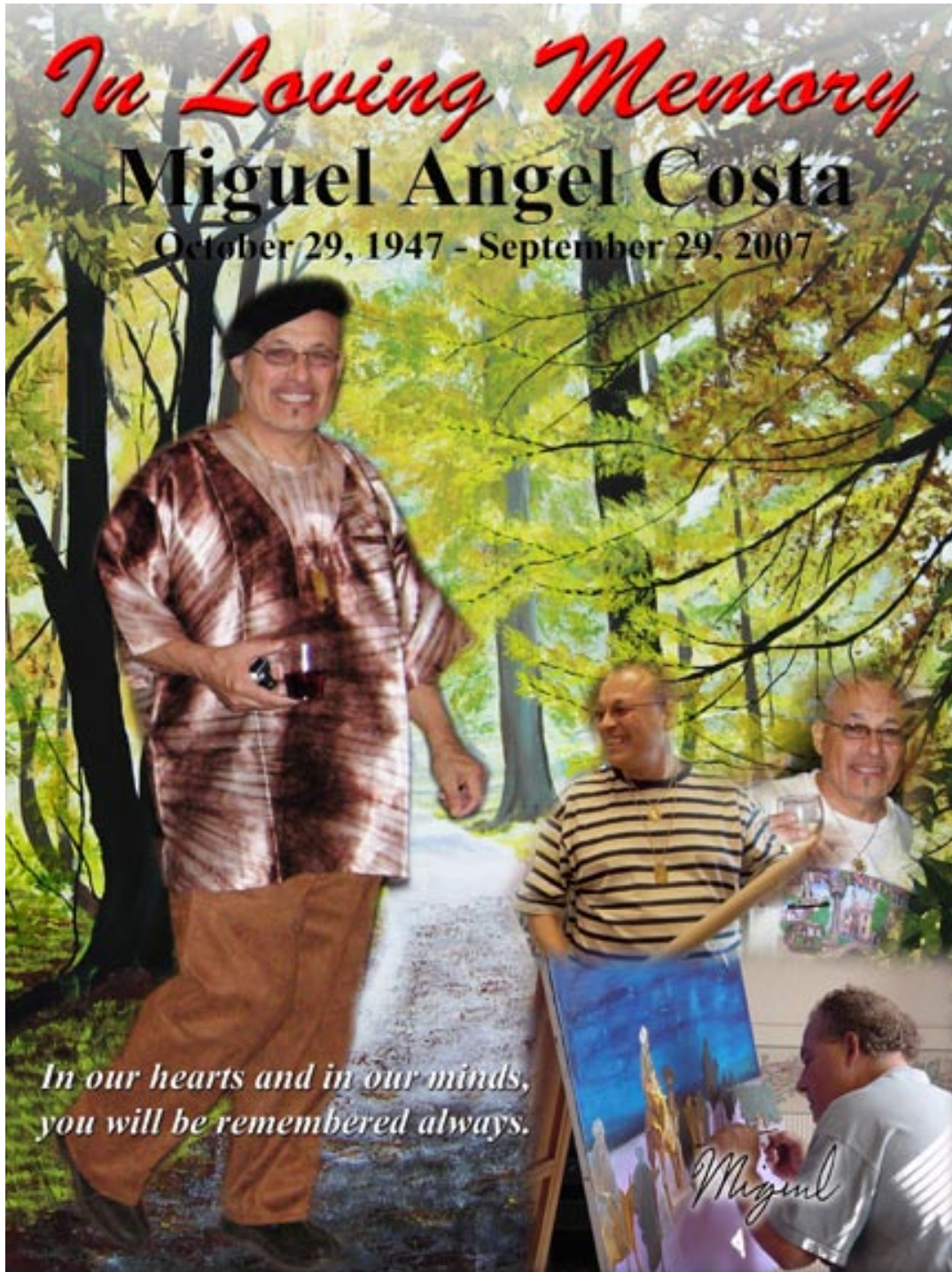
October 15, 2007 Board Meeting
